Superintendent Anderson reported that the elementary spelling contest that was to be held in Gregory this year was cancelled. Gregory will host next year's spelling contest. There will be no school on January 18<sup>th</sup> for observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day. On February 16<sup>th</sup>, Gregory is going to host a local small group vocal and instrumental contest. Parent/Teacher conferences are to be held on February 11<sup>th</sup>. The plan as of now is to hold conferences virtually. The deadline for spending the Coronavirus Relief Funds has been moved back to December 31, 2021. The ionization system for the heating and cooling system will be installed soon. Anderson will be having a conference call for updating the security systems for the school. The Gregory School District is up for a Title I review this year. The local legislatures were contacted about meeting with the school board. There could potentially be a cracker barrel event on a weekend in Gregory, where the legislatures would attend and the board could meet with them on the day of that event.
