**UNAPPROVED REGULAR MEETING MINUTES**

The Gregory School District 26-4 Board of Education met August 9, 2021 at 5:30 pm in the high school conference room. The following board members were present: Karen Timanus, Todd Schweigert, Cara Hull, and Jason Frasch. Absent: Katie Bolander.

Other officers and persons present: Sara Anderson, Superintendent, Jeff Determan, PK-12 Principal, Kevin Myrmoe, Business Manager, Patty Connealy, Gregory Times-Advocate, Blair Sedlacek, Caitlin Serr, Hank Wonnenberg, Melissa Wonnenberg, and Andy Wonnenberg.

The meeting was called to order by Karen Timanus and the pledge of allegiance was recited.

During the bus route meeting, Hank Wonnenberg expressed his concerns over the bus route that his children ride. In his area where he lives, there are approximately 15 students that ride the bus. His children get on the bus at 6:50 am as they are one of the first students to be on the bus, and do not get home until 4:30 pm as they are one of the last students to be dropped off. Wonnenberg proposed considering that the children who are picked up in the morning first are dropped off first after school. This would keep the students from having such long days from riding on the bus. H. Wonnenberg also stated his concerns about the students getting to school on time, especially when the weather is good. Melissa Wonnenberg said that when the students get to school late, they are missing out on work and work time and that they are showing up to school stressed out. Caitlin Serr stated that the less time and less students on the bus, the safer the students will be. Superintendent Anderson said that the requests will be considered and a decision will be made after talking with the bus driver. H. Wonnenberg will be notified of the decision.

Superintendent Anderson stated that inservice for the staff will be on August 23<sup>rd</sup>. Open house will also be on August 23<sup>rd</sup> starting at 12:00 pm with a staggered schedule based on first letter of last name for elementary students and by grade level for high school and middle school students. There will be orientation for 6<sup>th</sup> grade students and new secondary students from 7:00-7:45 pm on August 23<sup>rd</sup>. The first day of school will be Wednesday, August 25<sup>th</sup> from 8:15-11:30 am with busses running but no food being served. Thursday, August 26<sup>th</sup> will be the first full day of school. Anderson has been in contact with a few entities about purchasing two used busses. All teaching positions have been filled as well as all extra duty positions for the first semester. Middle school boys' basketball, assistant high school play, and assistant high school track positions still remain unfilled. A food service and paraprofessional position still need to be filled. There has been no progress on the insurance hail damage project.

Principal Determan said that all fall activities have started with practice or will later on in the week. Middle school activities will start when the school year starts.
