Other officers and persons present: Sara Anderson, Superintendent, Jeff Determan, BK-12 Principal, Kevin Myrmoe, Business Manager, and Patty Connealy, Gregory Times-Advocate.

The meeting was called to order by Karen Timanus and the pledge of allegiance was recited.

During the visitors to the board meeting, Mr. Mark Braun talked about the community projects that each class of students completed. Begindergarten and kindergarten made art work for the nursing home residents. 1<sup>st</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade filled flowerpots for Main Street. 2<sup>nd</sup> grade cleaned up the buttes, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade cleaned up the park, 4<sup>th</sup> grade cleaned up the football field, and 5<sup>th</sup> grade cleaned up the drive inn movie theater and helped repaired a fence there. 7<sup>th</sup> grade washed fire trucks while 8<sup>th</sup> grade washed the ambulances and police cars. 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Principal Jeff Determan reported that elementary students are in the process of taking their field trips. May 10<sup>th</sup> is a busy day with kindergarten graduation at 1:00 pm, elementary open house at 2:00 pm, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade graduation at 7:00 pm, while Gregory hosts the SEDS Conference track meet that starts at 1:00 pm. On May 11<sup>th</sup>, elementary field day is at 9:00 pm and Baccalaureate is at 7:00 pm. May 12<sup>th</sup> is kindergarten round up and the last middle school dance of the year. The last day of school is Friday, May 13<sup>th</sup> with a 11:30 am dismissal. Graduation is Saturday, May 14<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 pm. Region track is May 19<sup>th</sup> at Platte and region golf is May 24<sup>th</sup> at Mitchell. State track is May 26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, and 28<sup>th</sup> at Sioux Falls, while state golf is June 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> at Rapid City. Summer school starts May 16<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 am for high school students, with two sessions. Four core classes are being offered each session with the opportunity of credit recovery. Elementary and middle school summer school starts June 7<sup>th</sup> and will run through the month of June on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Various skills will be focused on.

Superintendent Anderson stated that she attended a training for writing comprehensive plan. The company that is to install the video entry system is still waiting on parts to arrive. A homeland security grant was written and submitted to help with funding for replacing the phone system. The school is still waiting on hearing if the grant has been awarded to the school.

Jason Frasch informed the board that the state's attorney is not sure on what to do to with the lawsuits and dissolution of the Mid-Central Cooperative. The dissolution of the cooperative will look to wait until 2023 to happen.

Karen Timanus reported on CORE Educational Cooperative that they are still looking for a school psychologist, as another school psychologist resigned. Contracts were approved and the cooperative is looking to start an 18-21 year old day program.

It was moved by Bolander and seconded by Frasch to approve hiring of Caitlyn Weins, MS English/Language Arts teacher, for the 2022/23 school year at a salary of \$43,600.00. Yes: All present. Motion carried.

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It was moved by Hull and seconded by Schweigert to approve contract with Graves IT Solutions, Travis Graves, for the 2022-23 school year at \$1500.00 annually for 1 hour per month. Remote technical support services beyond 1 hour per month will be billed at \$100.00 per hour. Yes: All present. Motion carried.

It was moved by Frasch and seconded by Schweigert to approve the following votes for the SDHSAA: Division II Representative/Superintendent - Jeff Danielsen, Watertown; Amendment 1 - Yes; Amendment 2 - Yes; Amendment 3 - Yes, Amendment 4 - Yes; Amendment 5 - Yes; Amendment 6 - Yes; and Amendment 7 - Yes . Yes: All present. Motion carried.

It was moved by Hull and seconded by Bolander to approve bid from Puetz Design and Build for the Gregory School District addition and remodel project in the amount of \$2,840,000.00. Roll Call vote: Bolander - Aye, Hull - Aye, Schweigert – No, Frasch – Aye, Timanus – Aye. Motion carried.

It was moved by Schweigert and seconded by Frasch to approve formal request for lane change for Mike Murray, BA + 15. Yes: All present. Motion carried.

It was moved by Bolander and seconded by Hull to approve consideration of allowing student athletes from the Burke School District to participate in competitive cheer & dance for the 2022-23 school year. Yes: All present. Motion carried.

It was moved by Schweigert and seconded by Hull to approve consideration of sharing cost of assistant wrestling coach for the B/G Storm Wrestling program with the Burke School District for the 2022-23 school year. Yes: All present. Motion carried.

It was moved by Bolander and seconded by Schweigert to approve classified raise due (.25¢ per hour) to continuing education for Ashley Lozano and Julia Opp for the 2022-23 school year. Yes: All present. Motion carried.

It was moved by Hull and seconded by Frasch to approve executive session for negotiations, SDCL 1-25-2(4). Yes: All present. Motion carried. Entered executive session at 5:08 pm. Exited executive session at 5:19 pm. Out of executive session, it was moved by Schweigert and seconded by Bolander to approve a 4.5% raise for currently contracted certified staff for the 2022-23 school year and an increase of \$45/month towards health insurance, and a \$1.00/hour raise to current classified staff for the 2022-23 school year and an increase of \$45/month towards health insurance. Yes: All present. Motion carried.

It was moved by Frasch and seconded by Schweigert to approve executive session for student issue, SDCL 1-25-2(2). Yes: All present. Motion carried. Entered executive session at 5:21 pm. Exited executive session at 5:40 pm. No motion made out of executive session.

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It was moved by Schweigert and seconded by Frasch to approve hiring of certified staff for the 2022-23 school year. Yes: All present. Motion carried.

It was moved by Bolander and seconded by Schweigert to approve hiring of classified staff for the 2022-23 school year. Yes: All present. Motion carried.

It was moved by Frasch and seconded by Schweigert to adjourn the board meeting at 5:47 pm. Yes: All present. Motion carried.
