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REGULAR BOARD MEETING CONTINUED

Principal Determan stated that the Smarter Balance Testing window is now open. Spring activities are beginning. FFA has a couple of competitions this week. Dakota Players Children's Theater is in Gregory the week of March 20th, with the performance scheduled for 1:00 pm on March 25th. Large group music contest is March 22nd in Mitchell. Eli Barreto will be playing at all-state band in Sioux Falls on March 23rd-25th. Dinner and a show will be at the auditorium on March 30th. There is a 1:30 pm dismissal for school on March 29th for staff inservice. The middle school play will be March 31st and April 1st at the Dixon Town Hall. Midterm for the fourth quarter is April 5th. On April 6th, school will be dismissed at 1:30 pm and no school on April 7th and 10th for Easter break.

Superintendent Anderson discussed the possibility of the school purchasing the four lots south of the school from the city. This land could be used for a larger parking lot in the future. An update was given on the remodel/addition project. Kindergarten and 8th grade graduation will be moved to May 16th. The DARE program is looking to be revitalized and the hopes that it will be in place for next school year. Anderson talked about her testifying before the appropriations committee in regards to the CTE program.

Bolander reported on CORE that they had a regular meeting.

Frasch gave a legislative update in regards to legislation regarding education.

Old Business:

An annual election will not be conducted because there was not a contested vacancy on the school board. This is required to be noted in the school board minutes per SDCL 13-7-30. One petition was submitted for the one vacancy. Jason Frasch will be sworn in for a 3-year term at the July school board meeting.

New Business:

It was moved by Bolander and seconded by Schweigert to approve resignation from JoAnn Serr at the close of the 2022/23 school year. Yes: All present. Motion carried. The board thanked Mrs. Serr for her 29 years of service to the school district.

It was moved by Frasch and seconded by Schweigert to approve extension of 2022/23 school year due to snow days: additional school days May 18th and 19th. Yes: All present. Motion carried.

It was moved by Bolander and seconded by Hull to approve executive session for negotiations, SDCL 1-25-2(4). Yes: All Present. Motion carried. Entered executive session at 6:19 pm. Exited executive session at 7:23 pm.

It was moved by Schweigert and seconded by Frasch to approve executive session for personnel, SDCL 1-25-2(1). Yes: All Present. Motion carried. Entered executive session at 7:24 pm. Exited executive session at 7:38 pm.
