There is no school on November 27th-29th for comp day for teacher conferences on the 27th and Thanksgiving break on the 28th and 29th. State FFA is in Rapid City on December 1st and 2nd. High school boys basketball practice starts December 2nd. State oral interp contest is in Sturgis on December 6th and 7th. The 6-12 holiday concert is at 7:00 pm at the auditorium on December 9th.
